HEADS UP – CONCUSSION INFORMATION



In August 2011, Missouri's new law, The Interscholastic Youth Sports Brain Injury Prevention Act was passed. At Green Park we are educating teachers, coaches and parents about the signs and symptoms of a concussion. Attached is an article about concussions. If your child is a suspect of a concussion and has any one of the symptoms, please notify your physician and/or seek immediate medical attention. If your child has been diagnosed with a concussion, please send written permission from their physician to resume any sports, gym or recess activity. Children should never return to sports or recreational activities on the same day the injury occurred. Please read the article included with the Green Sheet attachments so that you are aware of all the signs and symptoms of a concussion.
