Auction FAQ's

What is the auction?

The Green Park auction is the greatest single fundraiser undertaken by the GPLS community in support of the school. It is open to all parents, staff, association congregation members, and guests. The evening opens with a silent auction, followed by dinner and the exciting live auction.

When and where is the auction held?

Our auction is held every two years - this year, the auction is slated for Friday, March 28, 2014. It will be held at Royale Orleans Banquet Center at 2801 Telegraph Road, St. Louis MO, 63128.

What are the goals for the auction?

There are two goals for the Green Park auction.

- 1. To raise money. The money raised from the auction greatly benefits our children's school. Proceeds from this year's auction will be used to purchase more mobile technology for our classrooms, upgrades for Theater/Drama productions (particularly stage curtain refurbishment and replacement), general facilities improvements and enhanced classroom programming and curriculum updates.
- 2. To provide an opportunity for all Green Park families, friends and supporters to come together and celebrate our school community and our common interest in Christian education.

Our financial goal for this year's auction is \$40,000.00

Does the school hire a staff to run the Auction?

The Green Park Auction Committee is composed entirely of volunteers, including parents, friends, faculty, students, alumni, grandparents, and board members.

The Auction Committee oversees the auction with teams handling various aspects of the auction. The combined effort of all Green Park families and volunteers is critical to make this important event a success.

Where do the auction items come from?

Generous businesses, parents, friends, faculty, alumni, board members, and benefactors of Green Park Lutheran School donate all of the items for the Auction.

How do I make a donation?

Fill out a donation form describing the item and showing its market value, along with the donor information. The donor keeps the pink copy for their records, and the yellow and white copies are brought into the school with the donation (cash, gift certificate or physical item).

How much do auction items cost?

There are items for everyone's budget. The Auction has items starting as low as \$10 (Silent Auction) and go up to several thousands of dollars (Live Auction).
